Important to Know of Set-Up and Process

What expertise do we require of our Story Facilitators?

Your workshop needs to have been taught at least once and have 1-3 testimonials from those past attendees. You are required a minimum of three years of experience in your field. You can be from a number of professions such as Story Artists, Educators, Managers, Librarians, Authors, Musicians, etc.

What information is needed on the application to be considered one of our Story Facilitators?

We need basic contact information as well as: workshop title, workshop outline (handout could take the place of outline), summary for advertising purposes, bio, and confirmation about copyright and compensation offered.

How comfortable must you be with Zoom or virtual means to teach workshops?

No matter your Zoom experience, **we do a Test Run for about 30 minutes about a week before** the scheduled workshop to check on lighting, sound, and Internet connection. We will work with you.

What is the compensation plan?

Fees from the participants are a sliding scale tuition with \$5 minimum, \$25 suggested, though allow upwards to \$50. By default, we do a 80/20 split with 80% given to the Story Facilitator. You can choose to give a higher percentage to Story Crossroads out of kindness, which is tax deductible due to being a 501(c)(3) nonprofit. The 20% going to Story Crossroads assists in tech and marketing costs. The presenter can determine if a minimum number of registrants must be met to continue with the workshop. No flat fees are given and marketing is equally promoted by you and Story Crossroads.

What happens when participants pay \$25+?

The audio/video from the Zoom meeting will be sent to through wetransfer.com to their emails. These recordings are labeled "FOR PERSONAL USE ONLY" with reminders of that to the involved participants. Your contact/digital release repeats these details. You will receive these recordings to do what you wish.
